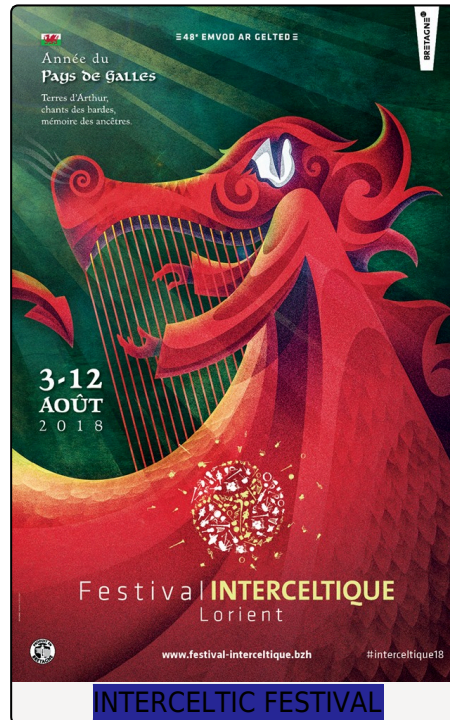

In 2003, 60 years after the destruction of the old theatre, the Grand Théâtre was completed. This building was designed by the architect

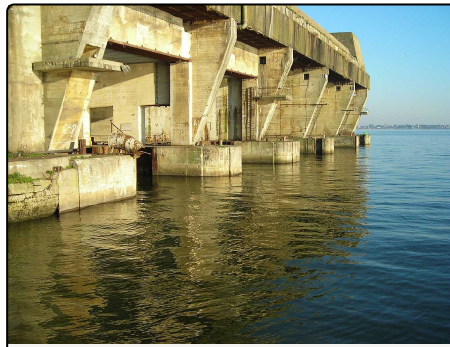
